[female voice] Some infections are becoming harder to treat with common antibiotics. You may or may not show symptoms and you could pass the infection on to others.

[Strong voice] **When infection strikes, you won't always need an antibiotic. But when you do, your doctor or primary care nurse will prescribe one for you. It's important to continue with the prescription until it's finished – even if you start to feel better before the medication is done. If you don't finish the antibiotic prescribed by your doctor or nurse, you can increase the chance that in the future that antibiotic might not work as well on those infections in the future.**

[female] **It's good to finish your antibiotics when prescribed by your doctor or nurse. Don't share your antibiotic prescription with others – even if you think they have the same illness!**
